What is Hospice?

Hospice is a philosophy of care for people who are nearing the end of their lives. The emphasis is on comfort care rather than curative treatment.

Hospice care combines pain and symptom management with practical and emotional support in the comfort of the patient's home. Hospice services are also available at area skilled nursing and assisted living facilities and any place the patient calls "home".

*Live every day as fully as possible.
Hospice can help make that happen!*

The Hospice of Amador and Calaveras Team focuses on meeting the needs of patients and their families. Specialized support and care are carried out under the direction of your personal physician and/or our medical director.

Our team approach enhances the quality of life and is part of what makes hospice care unique.

You, or a loved one, may be eligible for hospice care:

- If you want to spend your final days living your life to the fullest extent possible.
- If curative treatment is no longer an option and you prefer palliative care.
- If your physician has recommended hospice care.
- If you or your loved one is diagnosed with a terminal illness and may have less than 6 months to live.

Who Pays for Hospice Care?

Medicare, Medi-Cal, most insurance companies and HMOs cover the majority of hospice care. In addition, Hospice of Amador and Calaveras receives financial support from the community, United Way, proceeds from our thrift stores, grants, fundraisers, and individual donations which allow us to meet our mission of providing quality care to everyone who needs it regardless of their ability to pay.

Services:

Hospice of Amador & Calaveras provides a team-based approach – physicians, nurses, home health aides, social workers, spiritual counselors and volunteers to develop a personal care plan.

Our team:

- Provides pain and symptom management; available in person or by phone 24-hours a day.
- Offers emotional support, help with financial/legal options, and resources.
- Assists with personal care and hygiene.
- Provides caregivers with support and respite.
- Consults with patient's physician and other team members to manage patient care.
- Offers assistance in obtaining spiritual comfort if desired.
- May provide physical, occupational or speech consultation.
- Provides counseling and support groups.
- Grief services for children and teens (Grief-busters Program)
